- Work w/ TDT Director to communicate route to appropriate traffic officials
- Work w/ TDT Director & TREE Fund staff to acquire necessary permits
- Work w/ TDT Director & TREE Fund staff to secure escorts as necessary
- Mark route for cyclists per standardized criteria developed by TDT Director
